







THE BUR OAK

(Quercus macrocarpa)

- Found in midwestern and north-central American forests
- · Slow growing, large deciduous tree
- Growth rate of 1' per year when young
- Grows up to 100' tall
- One of the largest oaks with a trunk diameter of up to 10'
- Grows in hot, dry, open areas, away from forest canopy
- · Bark is a medium gray and somewhat rugged
- Flowers are greenish-yellow catkins, produced in the spring
