







PECAN

(Carya illinoinensis)

- Found in USDA Plant Hardiness zones 5-9
- · Grow in moist woods, particularly along rivers or in bottomland flats
- · Require large quantities of water during the growing season
- Can grow over 150' (2-4' per year), trunks can measure over 3' in diameter
- Begins producing nuts within 3-4 years of maturity
- · As a member of the hickory family, they provide edible nuts for humans and animals
- · Average lifespan is approximately 300 years
- Bark appears red-brown with platy scales
- · Leaflets are double-toothed, yellow-green, and smooth
